Why Counties Need TIP

Traditional juvenile interventions often focus on punishment, compliance, or symptoms.

Many youth complete diversion programs without ever learning why they continue making the same decisions, and how to change it.

TIP™ addresses the missing piece:

Personal ownership

Rather than asking youth to simply "behave better," TIP™ teaches them how their thoughts, emotions, nervous system, family experiences, beliefs, and choices work together; and how to interrupt unhealthy behavioral patterns before they become lifelong habits.

Who Does TIP Serve?

TIP™ serves youth ages 10–18 through partnerships with communities in several ways:

- County Licensing (diversion / probation)
- School Partnerships (ISS)
- Community Organizations (first time offender)
- Family Support Agencies (low risk youth)
- Nonprofit Organizations (informal adjustment)
